Joseph Pt. 1 – Dreams Delayed Genesis 37, 39 & 40 Series: Genesis – The Story of Us All

Central Passage

Genesis 37:5–11 (ESV) — 5 Now Joseph had a dream, and when he told it to his brothers they hated him even more. ... 8 His brothers said to him, "Are you indeed to reign over us? Or are you indeed to rule over us?" So they hated him even more for his dreams and for his words. 9 Then he dreamed another dream and told it to his brothers ... 10 But when he told it to his father and to his brothers, his father rebuked him and said to him, "What is this dream that you have dreamed? Shall I and your mother and your brothers indeed come to bow ourselves to the ground before you?" 11 And his brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the saying in mind.

Central Thought: God uses difficult people and challenging circumstances to deepen our faith and develop our character so that his dreams for us will come true.

Matthew 16:24 (ESV) — 24 *Then Jesus told his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.*

God Dreamers and Christ Followers are often...

- Misunderstood and mistreated by their families (Gen. 37)
- Pursued and persecuted by pagans (Gen. 39)
- ✤ Abandoned by those they assist (Gen. 40)

When Dreams are Delayed...

- ♦ We can honor God regardless of the circumstances.
- We can know that God is with us and working for our good and his glory.

Genesis 39:2 (ESV) — 2 The LORD was with Joseph, and he became a successful man, and he was in the house of his Egyptian master...

Genesis 39:21–23 (ESV) —21 But the LORD was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison. 22 And the keeper of the prison put Joseph in charge of all the prisoners who were in the prison. Whatever was done there, he was the one who did it. 23 The keeper of the prison paid no attention to anything that was in Joseph's charge, because the LORD was with him. And whatever he did, the LORD made it succeed.

1 Peter 4:19 (NIV) — **19** So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful Creator **and continue to do good**.

Colossians 3:23–24 (NIV) —23 Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, 24 since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

James 1:2–4 (ESV) — 2 Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, 3 for you know that the testing of your faith produces stead-fastness. 4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
